Larry Bennett, 79-year-old, was admitted to the hospital for respiratory failure and numerous on-going problems noted since May. Mr. Bennett received OT, PT, and ST since admission and has been diligent with all therapy tasks and recommendations. When he arrived, he was on a mechanical soft diet. However, with the help of ST and consistent completion of tongue strengthening exercises and use of safe swallow strategies, he has now upgraded to a diet of regular consistency with chopped meats.

Larry had high hopes of being able to walk again. He was only able to walk 5-10 ft with a walker and required extensive help for all ADL tasks. Through hard work, perseverance and the help of OT and PT, his balance improved, and he is now walking 300 ft without a walker and able to do ADL care with little to no assistance. Due to his excellent progress, Larry plans to return home with family in the next few days. He reports that he is pleased with his care and his progress with therapy.
